- Understand the importance of ahealthy parentteacher/child relationship and communicate any concerns in a constructive, appropriate and polite manne
- Make use of communications channels
- Minimise gossip and hears by communicating with the School if an issue arises
- Cooperate when you child's behaviour has overstepped accepted school standards
- Encourage community building and inclusivity with otperents and members of the Carrhe School Community
- Ensure your child arrives School on time, incorrect uniform and fit to contribute to the school day

## Parent/Caregiver Rights

Parents and caregivers have the right:

- To be treated with respect, professionalismareand courtesy by staff, students and other parents
- To be listened to and clearly communicated with by the School, in regard to your child's education and developmen
- To have confidentiality over sensitive issues respected by staff
- To receive a timely response to concerns raised

## Parent/Caregiver Responsibilities

Parents and caregivers are expected to:

- Not approach another child in the care of the school to addiesses r chastise them
- Respect the reputation of the staff and other students at the School, being mindful of communications, including the tone of emails **ahe** content ofpostings on social media
- Communicate any concerns in a constructive, appropriate and polite manner

Vexatious complaints, deliberate breaches and inability to respect and adhere to the Parent Code of Conductmay result in the exclusion of a parent/caregiver from compus and/or possible termination of their children's enrolment.
